

**EcoSeal Bio-Restore 800** cleaned and **EcoSeal Nano Seal 227T Concrete Sealer** sealed and preserved projects



Old grave stone left half wet before **Bio-Restore** applied. **Bio-Restore** applied shows red tint. Red tint disappears as **Bio-Restore** reacts with bio pollutants and stains. Red will completely disappear as stone is naturally cleaned. **Bio-Restore** can be left to clean on its own, taking from a week to a month or more, depending on how soiled the object is and weather conditions. The process may be accelerated by gently scrubbing with a soft bristled brush (steel or stiff brush can damage object), rinsing and scrubbing further until stain disappears and repeating the application process if necessary. Once cleaned to satisfaction, apply **EcoSeal 227T** per directions to maintain new stone appearance and inhibit darkening from atmospheric pollutants and regrowth of fungus.
